APPLY FOR A \$ 7,500 COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

In conjunction with the annual City of Stamford Citizen of the Year program, scholarships of up to \$7,500 are awarded by J WV Community Scholarships, Inc. to graduating seniors who have provided outstanding community service to the City of Stamford.

Students from both public and private high schools are eligible to apply.

To be eligible for a **COTY-JWV Community Service Scholarship**, an applicant must be a high school senior, attending school in, or residing in Stamford. A significant portion of the applicant's community service must have benefitted the Stamford Community. Scholarship recipients will receive grants of up to \$7,500 to be used for higher education at an accredited institution of their choice.

The selection committee will choose recipients based on the student's exemplary volunteer service in Stamford, leadership roles, letters of recommendation and academic performance.

Religious affiliation is neither a requirement nor considered in the selection process.

In conjunction with the annual City of Stamford Citizen of the Year event, scholarships of up to \$7,500 are awarded by the Fred Robbins Post 142 of the Jewish War Veterans of the United States, Stamford, CT to graduating seniors who have provided outstanding community service in the City of Stamford.

This scholarship is **Community Service** -based and **non-sectarian**.
Religious affiliation is **neither** a requirement **nor** a consideration.

Students from both public and private high schools are eligible to apply.

To be eligible for a COTY– JWV Community Service Scholarship, a student must be a high school senior attending school in, or residing in Stamford. Scholarship winners will receive grants of up to \$7,500 to be used for higher education at an accredited institution of their choice.

Recipients will be selected based on their:

- Exemplarily volunteer service benefiting the Stamford Community,
- Leadership roles, if any,
- Letters of recommendation (see below)

This should be laid out in a clear and easy to read format.
- Official school transcript.
